Marion Goldwasser (left) spoke with DG Lloyd Navarro and DG Elect Claudia Cannady after the club meeting on Tuesday, August 29.

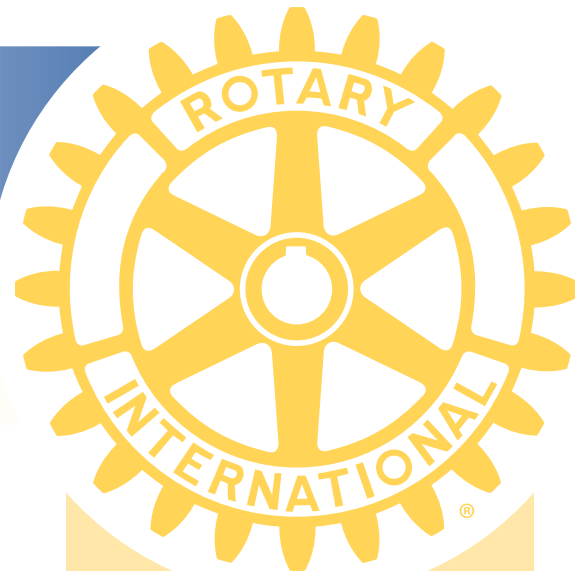
