Guardian Ad Litem, Volunteers Needed

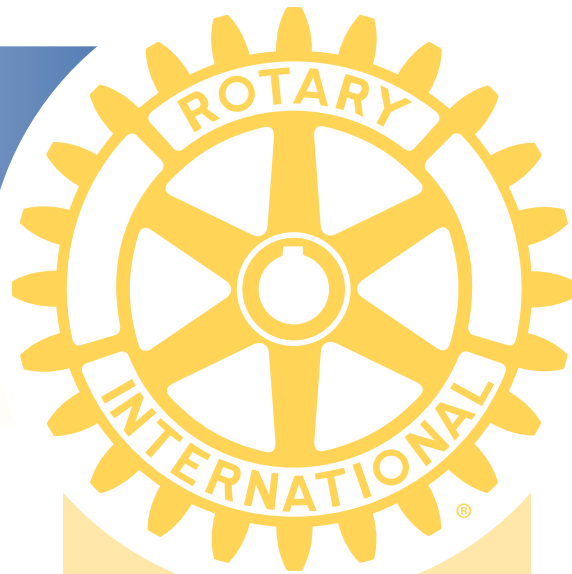

Why Giving Blood is so Important

Our Rotary club held a blood drive April 3 at Cross Creek Country Club which brought in 24 units of blood. Our goal was 22!

Lynn Wilkes from Red Cross explained that someone needs blood every 2 seconds. The need for blood is constant due to the shelf life of blood. Red blood cells expire after 42 days, and platelets expires after 5 days. The Red Cross is a national supplier of blood but they meet the needs of your local community first.

In Lynn's case, blood helped her Nephew, Ryan when he was a premature infant and then again in January of this year. Ryan needed surgery for tubes in his ears and although the surgery went well, Ryan did not recover as expected and developed a brain infection which caused several brain bleeds. Ryan died January 27. But the blood products he received helped to sustain him as he tried to recover. Even though Ryan lost his battle, he is helping Lynn to spread the message of how important it is to give.

Giving blood requires nothing more than a giving heart and to be willing to endure a pinch in the arm but yet can do so much!
