Super Intendant, Travis Reeves and Next Generation Career Academy student, Hosinia, spoke about the progress that has been made to help students bridge College credits while still in High School. With the help of Surry Community College and a \$330,000 grant from Golden Leaf, the school system has been able to hire a career counselor and provided paid internships for students like Hosinia.

Since 2012 this program has allowed parents to save \$1 million dollars in college costs and in 2017 that savings was \$300,000. The success of our students depends on innovative thinking by the school systems to help individuals get ahead by having these flexible schedules while in high school.
