Firoz Peera Speaks about Service as a Rotarian

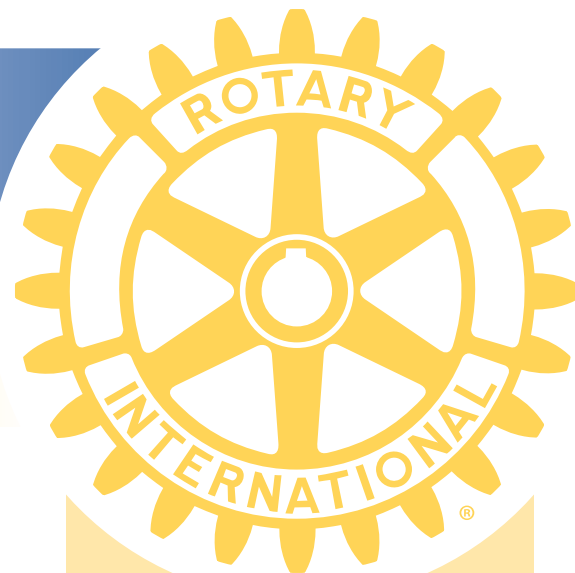
