Meals On Wheels Rolls into Rotary Meeting



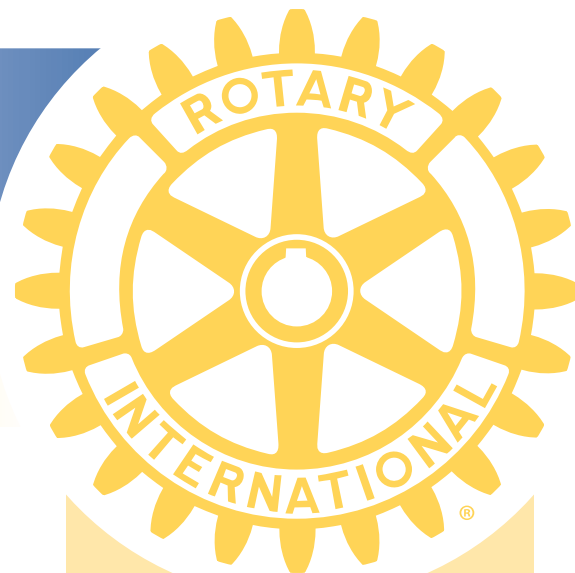
