## **BARRY CLEMENT & TERESA LEWIS**

Barry Clement and Teresa Lewis share with the Noon Club their story dealing with FTD or Frontotemporal Degeneration .

This disease differs from Alzheimer's by having a gradual, progressive decline in behavior, language or movement, while memory usually is relatively preserved. It also strikes younger people and the majority of cases occur between 45-64.

The progression of the disease varies but usually behavior, language and movement begin to decline and the progression can range from 2 to 20 years.

The average life expectancy is 7 to 13 years after the onset of symptoms.
